1. Skater must be registered with Skate Canada. 2. Skater must be registered at least 3 days/week with another club. 3. A certified Skate Canada coach in good standing must be on the ice at all times. 4. Foreign skaters must show proof of Sport Accident Insurance. 5. Payment must be made prior to using any ASC ice. 6. Skaters must sign in at the ASC club office. Fees: Daytime Ice Program: \$15 (2 hour session) Evening/Weekend session with off ice fitness: \$25 Evening/Weekend session without off ice fitness: \$20 - Limit of 6 guest passes per person unless other arrangements have been made. - Guest use is subject to availability Please contact ASC if you are interested in guest skating. The fee is paid annually each September, and is mandated by Skate Canada. The fee covers registration, accident insurance and a safe sport fee. If you have registered at another club, then you may select the option to remove this fee when you register. New skaters to the spring session (ie. those who did not skate in the fall will still have to pay the Skate Canada fee.
